"Golden Grove"

Ancient Roman calendars, modeled after the lunar cycle, called the middle of the month "The Ides". This ideation from old to new marks the midway threshold of the planetary passages.

In Sonoma lore, Wiliam B. Ide presided over the rebellious "California Republic", an independent nation that, in the summer of 1846, existed for 25 days in between Mexican and American governance of the region. This quixotic moment in time was California's Ide.

SONOMA COUNTY SOURCING

Greater Sonoma County encompasses 19 distinct viticultural growing areas, all with unique terroir. IDE wines are comprised of different AVA's ranging massively, from the higher-elevation mountain vineyards to cool, fog-covered Pacific coastal vineyards. This allows us to hand-pick the best grapes from vintage to vintage, for each varietal. Sonoma County is home to some of the most prestigious coastal Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, as well as produces the deep fruit flavors of Cabernet and sun-ripened tropical Sauvignon Blanc from the lower valleys. Welcome to the other side.

TASTING NOTE

This Sonoma County Sauvignon Blanc is bright and aromatic. Notes of tropical fruit lead to flavors of juicy stonefruit, peach blossom and honeyed oak. This wine is crisp and excellently balanced with bright acid, it's finish leaves you wanting more.
